This half term our topic is Great Britain. The children will be learning about the four countries of the Great Britain and will have the opportunity to compare this to life in Cornwall.



In English, we will be learning a non-fiction text about the United Kingdom. The children will get the opportunity to create leaflets and present writing electronically as well.



In Science this term, we will be studying famous scientists, some of whom will be from Great Britain. We will be looking at how they made significant discoveries that influence us today.
