The friends in this story walk along with a stranger recounting the stories about him.

It is not until they sit down and share bread that they realise the 'stranger' is Jesus.

In the story the friend walking along the Road feel a range of emotions, from sadness to surprise, joy, elation and a sense of needing to gp out and tell others what had happened on their journey to Emmaus.
