



Dear Parent/Carer,

The school has been asked to take part in an exciting pilot project in partnership with Cornwall Council Library and Information Service to try out a new free electronic library that can be accessed via any tablet, phone or mobile device that is able to download an app. Each child in the school will be given an electronic library card number which will allow them free access to e-books and e-audiobooks through the Borrowbox library app.

Children will be able to access this material in school and from home if a mobile device is available.

If you wish to access from home the membership number will be in the front of your child’s reading diary and planner. You will need to:

- Download the **Borrowbox** app
- Sign in using an email address- preferably that of a parent (if you are unable to do this then feel free to use this email borboxstmaryspz@gmail.com).
- In the Library box select **Cornwall Libraries Primary School**
- Type your membership number in the **Borrower Number** box
- Your **PIN** is the last 4 digits of your membership number
- You’re all set. Start reading or listening!

(Just like in a real library some books will have waiting lists. If a book you want is not available immediately click **Reserve** and add yourself to the end of the queue. If waiting lists become too long Cornwall Libraries will buy extra copies.)

If you wish to upgrade this electronic membership to a full Cornwall Library membership then you can join up for free at Penzance Library in St John’s Hall (or any other library in Cornwall) and have access to the huge range of Books, DVDs, and activities that are available.

If your child already has a Cornwall Library Card they can of course use this. However you may prefer to use this new membership number when using Borrowbox as it will only contain children’s books.

This is a fantastic opportunity and we hope that you will be able to take the opportunity to access the e-library.
