In English, we will be learning to:

- Understand the features of and learn to write: information texts, adventure stories and persuasive writing.
- Identify and use the subjunctive form to create formality in our writing.
- Use colons to expand on our ideas and semi-colons to join two sentences that are closely linked.
- Be improving our skills of inference when reading by using evidence from the text to support our answer.

How you can help?

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- Talk to your child about what they have learnt about information texts.
- Look at age appropriate information texts that you may have at home and discuss their features: photographs, captions, factual information, words linked to the subject area.
- Encourage the children to do their grammar

The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas

In **Topic**, we will be learning:

That the location of a place determines its climate and some of its physical features.

- That different parts of the world can have similar climates and physical features
- That an area can be navigated using a map and a compass.

In RE, we will be learning:

- That different parts of the Bible tell us why Christians believe in the resurrection.
- That belief in the resurrection can lead Christians to have hope.
- That building up to the resurrection, Christians experience a range of emotions.

How you can help?

In Science, we will be learning:
