**Food packages for Free School Meal (FSM) Easter break arrangements**

**Please note this is for FSM Pupil Premium** children not Universal Free School Meals provided for Reception, Class 1 and Class 2. **We have sent you a text if you are eligible.**

We are collecting the food packages today. These are for the two weeks over the Easter Break.

Please collect your food package from school and comply with social distancing, please follow the instructions below:

- Please come during your allocated slot. This has been arranged to avoid large groups of people arriving at school at the same time  
Reception class            12:30- 1pm  
Class 1 and class 2        1pm -1:30pm  
Class 3                        1:30pm – 2pm  
Class 4                        2pm -2:30pm  
Class 5                        2:30pm -3pm  
Class 6                        3pm -3:30pm
- The food packages will be on tables, set 2m apart, outside the school building. Please collect package and then leave the site. **DO NOT COME INTO THE SCHOOL BUILDING.** A member of school staff will tick you off the list so we keep a record of who has collected their food package.
- Please observe social distancing, keeping a 2m distance from other parents and carers. Please ensure that only ONE person at a time is coming through the school gates.
- Please wait outside the gates if another parent or carer is collecting a food package so that you keep at least 2m apart. If there are other parents and carers collecting then queue outside the school gates, at least 2m apart.
- As soon as you get home, wash your hands.

We will distribute any uncollected packages if you are unable to get to school. We will be knocking on your door and then leaving the package outside, keeping a minimum 2m distance at all times. This will be from 5pm on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March.
